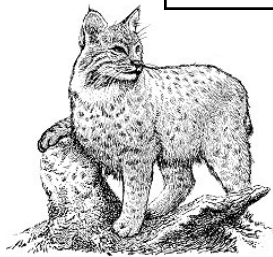
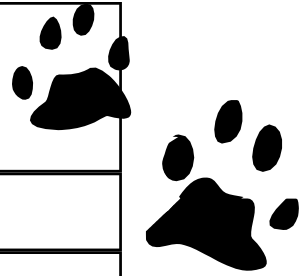

The Home is not supported by funding from the government, DSS, or foster care. It exists solely on donations from churches, individuals, and businesses. 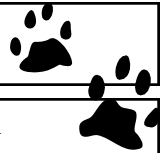

Second Grade Field Trip

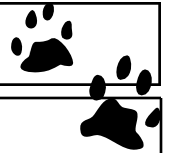
